FAQs and things to keep in mind:

- **Who can lead a workshop at Reservoir Community Farm?**
Anyone! We are looking for caring and creative individuals with skills they'd like to share.
- **What subjects can I lead a workshop on?**
We support workshops taught on a variety of subjects, like farming, gardening, composting, cooking, pickling, health and nutrition, exercise, meditation, crafting, and other forms of community resilience, as well as social justice workshops to strengthen community knowledge in topics like food and economic justice, organizing for action, applying for benefits, resume writing, and safely dealing with police. The more creative and social justice focused, the better!
- **Can I lead a series of workshops?**
Yes! In fact, we encourage it. But if you'd like to lead only one, that's just fine. Just make sure to plan with us so we can determine the best number of workshops and dates as a team!
- **When can I lead a workshop?**
We host events at the farm on Thursday nights from May through October, and some Saturdays by appointment.
- **What kind of work will I be doing?**
You will be leading a small group in the topic of your choice, with some support from farm staff.
- **How long is a workshop?**
About 45 minutes, give or take.
- **What support will be provided to me?**
We provide space, picnic tables, electricity, internet, garden tools, advertising, and outreach.
- **Will I be compensated?**
All workshops must be led on a volunteer basis as we do not have funding for them at this time.
- **Anything else I need to know?**
*The mission! **GVI's mission is to grow food, knowledge, leadership, and community through urban gardening and farming, to create a more just food system in Bridgeport.** That means that we here at RCF are interested in keeping our farm a safe and inclusive space for all, so we ask that you please leave biases and prejudices at the gate.*
