SEEDING & LABELING

Please read "<u>BASICS FOR SEEDING</u>" before you begin this process

- 1. Double check the Seeding List for the day to be sure you understand how many trays you will be using and that you have filled enough
- 2. Label ALL popsicle sticks you are using that day BEFORE you begin.
- 3. Write the date, the variety, and your initials, on BOTH SIDES of the popsicle stick in clear handwriting like this: *"3/7 Jalapeño F.C."*
- 4. Double check the seed packets you will be using to be sure they are correct
- 5. Examine the seeds you will be planting how thick are they?
- 6. Make a shallow indentation in each cell's soil with your finger or writing implement: **REMEMBER:** *****It is better to plant seeds too shallow than too deep as one can be fixed and the other leads to seed rot
- 7. Put a small number of seeds in your hand at a time (this is in case of spilling)
- 8. Put seeds in the hole according to directions, at times you will be asked to put 2-3 seeds in a cell, pay attention to the Seedling List
- 9. When you are done seeding a tray, put two popsicle sticks for that seed variety on either end of the tray on outside edges of cells.
- 10. Make sure the popsicle sticks are pushed all of the way down to the bottom of the cell so they don't fall out
- 11. Pinch soil from the edges of cells to cover the seed to cover it only twice as deeply as the seed is thick. *Do not push down on the soil*
